

International Checklist

post Arrival

1) Update your friends and family on your safe arrival

2) Check into your accommodation. International students have access to a free bedding set.

3) If you speak other languages or are learning one, consider joining our language café!

4) Use maps.chi.ac.uk to find your way around campus

5) Attend our International Orientation

6) Complete your in-person registration! Bring your passport, e-visa share code and boarding pass



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7) Once fully registered, collect your university student card from the reception in Bognor or Chichester

8) Take a look at the Students' Union and their activities

9) Get familiar with bus numbers, and download the Trainline app for train travel. We recommend buying a railcard

10) Open a bank account

11) Register with a doctor (it is important!)

12) Register for an English language support package if English isn't your first language (you get more time during in-person exams)
